Winter is closing in on Rock Harbor and we are beginning the process of blowing out the irrigation lines to prevent freezing. The application of preventative fungicides will be applied in the near future.

For you winter golfers, the pin placement is in the near center of each green. It will remain this way until we have a winter thaw or Spring, whichever comes first.

Last month I explained the anthracnose infection, we do believe at this point it is under control. Some greening up is occurring, but the bent grass is starting to go dormant. When Spring comes and after aerification, and top dressing things should be a lot better.

Notes From The G

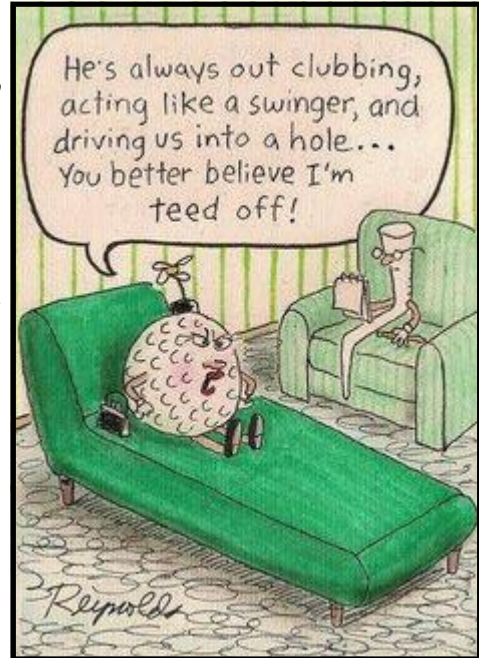
