Number 17 Rock is unique to the first time golfer because of the clearly visible heart shape and number 16 to the daily golfer because of all the unique challenges hole 16 has to offer.

On the Boulder Course I think one hole stands out to the first time golfer and the regular golfer alike, Boulder 13 "The Castle Hole". Very beautiful and yet intimidating to see. A challenging hole for all to play. There are a lot of places on this hole you don't want to put your tee ball. This might be the toughest putting green on the course?
