Come Spring, we will concentrate on getting control of the unwanted clover and crab grass. We will be aerifying and topdressing the fairways, which will improve turf quality level and fill in low spots. The greens have gotten a lot better and we are seeing improvement each week.

Number six and seven are in the worst condition. Number six is in need of better air flow, which will require the removal of some trees and underbrush around the green, all of which

we plan on doing this winter.

Number seven might require some sod planting around the fringe. Healing the green is very difficult once you have allowed play. You can help with this by not walking on the bare sports and thin areas on the green.

Thanks for bearing with us.

No. 6 Boulder still has a few bear spots on the green and around the cart path.
