Chris Dieter, Course Superintendent:

What's new, old, or coming up. Thanks again for all the kind words on course conditions. I will tell you I see the course through a different pair of glasses than everyone else. This year seems to be coming on as my most challenging. It is a bumper crop year for clover, which really came on following the cold temperatures after aerification. Kylinga and soft crabgrass are fighting their way onto the course in several areas. The Corona virus issue has brought on new challenges in managing employees and customers. Working through the change of an Assistant Superintendent also adds one more point for my attention. We will persevere to keep the course in conditions, which I hope keeps everyone happy.

We recently hired Joe Basile as our new Assistant Superintendent. After one day, he brings a new energy with his enthusiasm. (Read more about him in his interview in the insert). We are working over the weed problems as Joe Ott has been spraying. Nothing is more satisfying than seeing the clover start to wither the day after Mr. Ott has sprayed them.

In the next two weeks, we will be reseeding Rock #6 fairway. The process will begin by spraying all the weeds out of the fairway. The entire hole will be roped off from cart traffic. We will then heavily aeri-

fy the fairway, followed by seeding. It will be necessary to run some sprinklers during the day to keep the seed moist. The hole will not be taken out of play, so please take your divot bottle out to fix your divots.
